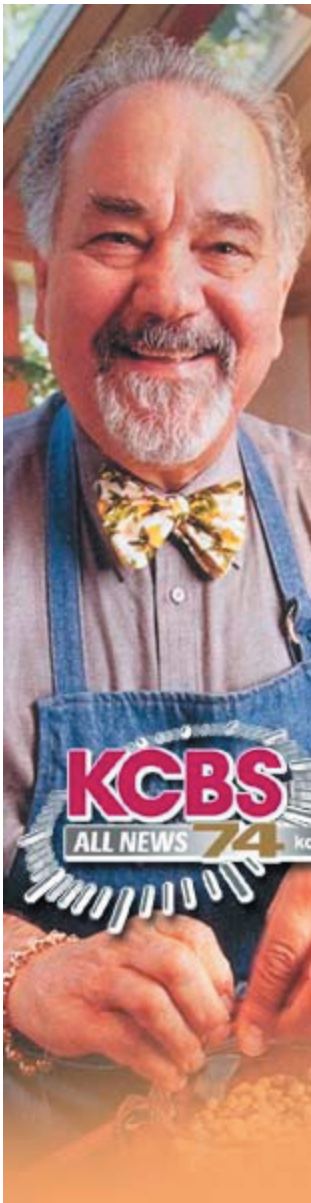

Soft and supple richness makes this very appealing.** Just pour a glass and enjoy it. But wait, there’s enough stuff here, enough substance to serve this with... how about maybe a lobster or a poultry dish that has a rich cream sauce...”
